
# Collaboration

## A Taster Activity

### ROW, ROW, ROW YOUR BOAT

### Organisation

- If you have talked about the story 'First time campers' emphasising the collaboration aspect, it would be helpful to do a quick activity to give the children a practical experience of this concept.
- If you don't already sing "Row, row, row your boat" with the children, it is very quick and easy to learn.
- Invite them to choose a partner and sit opposite each other, legs outstretched so the soles of their feet are flat against each other's and then ask them to hold hands.
- Now sing the song with the children rowing backwards and forwards together – simple but effective and it can't be done on your own!
- Ask the children to talk to each other about what each of them does to make it work.
- Let one or two children explain to the whole class.





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
