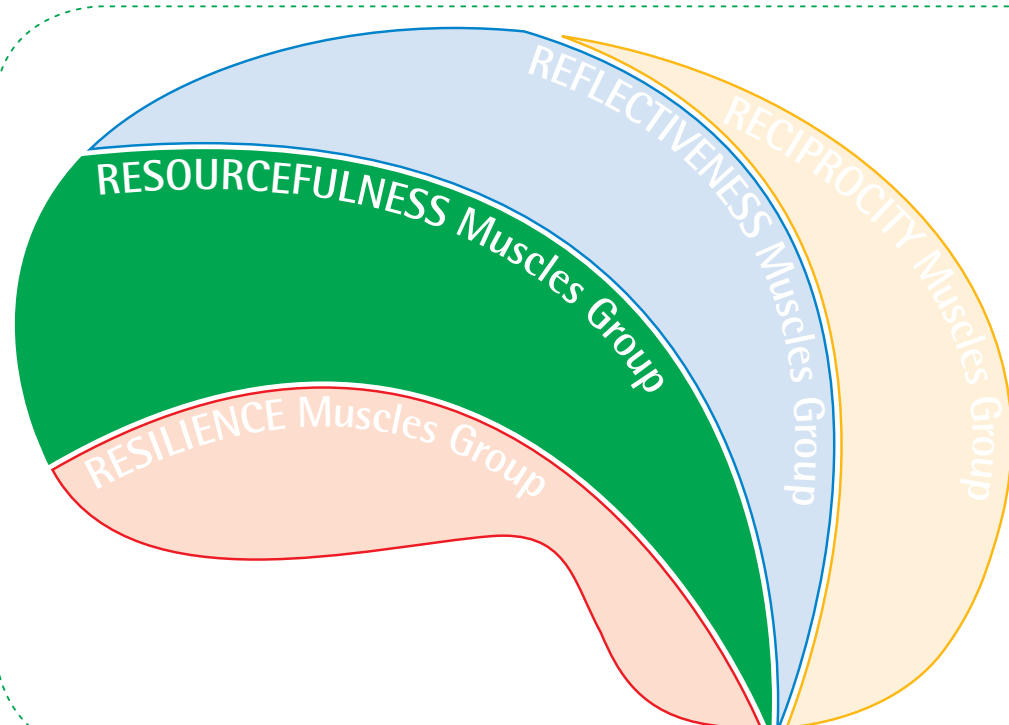
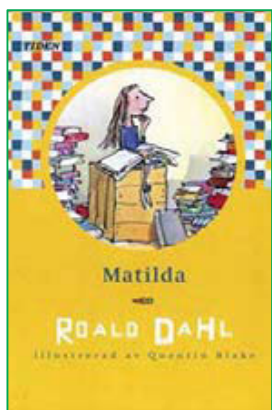


Linking Ideas — About Resourcefulness
