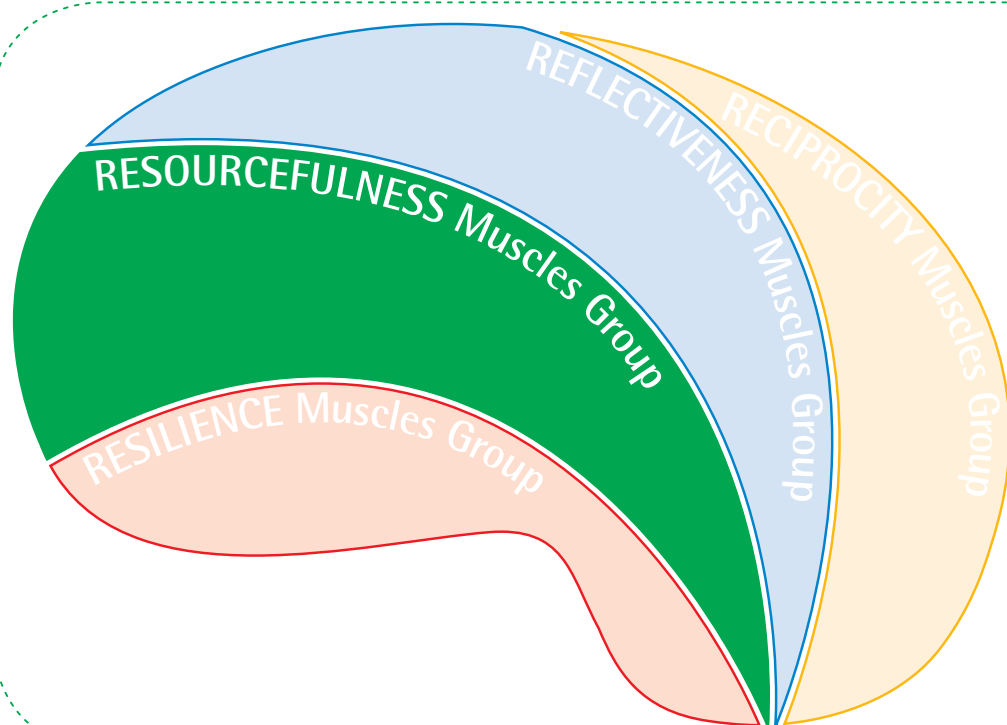

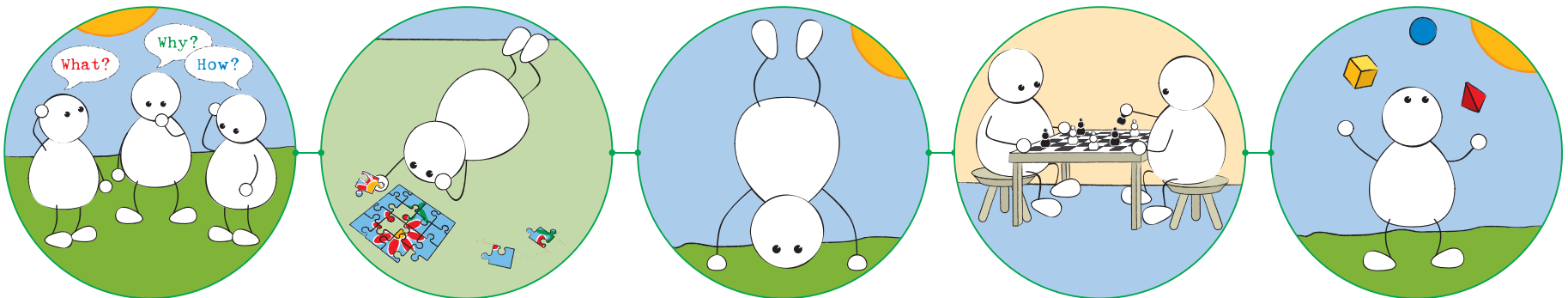


Resourcefulness — Imagining
