Activity 2: Classroom Climate for Planning

Students are expected to be well organised and prepared to learn.			
Routines like 'What will it look like when I've finished' are used frequently.			
The 'How' of goal setting is frequently discussed.			
Students explore and discover how best to plan (sequence and resource) their challenges or projects.			
Students are encouraged to view plans as tentative and open to review as circumstances change.			
Teachers plans for lessons are frequently shared and discussed with students.			
Students are encouraged to estimate how long a piece of work will take them to complete [without pressure].			
Students are enabled to help plan and manage parts of a lesson/assembly/school trip.			
Students are involved in planning a unit of work.			
Students are supported to review the effectiveness of their plans retrospectively.			
Displays and Celebrations			
Displays show a range of planning tools.			
Successful plans are celebrated and displayed.			
Unsuccessful plans are recognised as learning opportunities.
