

Does my classroom culture encourage revising?

This is a consistent feature in my classroom

This is an occasional feature in my classroom

This is rarely evident in my classroom

This is something I would like to work on

I help students to view corrections as an opportunity to improve further

I support students to change tack when / if necessary

I encourage students to view change as a natural part of learning

I focus my feedback on what is needed to improve

I use 'could be' language to stimulate learners to consider other possibilities

I regularly ask 'do you think that this is coming along well?'

I encourage students to monitor how things are going (ie traffic lights)

I embed frequent review points to encourage students to re-think

I give students opportunities to assess their own work against agreed criteria

I use the VTR 'I used to think . . .' to legitimise changes of mind

I deliberately create situations that require a change of mind / approach

I reward students for improvements on previous efforts using the Editor's Desk

We explore and celebrate different and alternative ways of doing things

Display includes a good balance of completed work and work in progress
